

<u>Home and Community Services Information System</u> of the Pennsylvania Office of Developmental Programs provides information about BEi services and rates, and other helpful information.

<u>Office of Developmental Programs</u> (ODP) is to support Pennsylvanians with developmental disabilities and their families to achieve greater independence, choice and opportunity in their lives. This resource center is the home for ODP's training, communications, and informational resources.

<u>Forest-Warren Counties Human Services</u> site provides information on eligibility and enrollment for BEi and other services for adults and children with disabilities.

<u>Warren County School District</u> site provides information regarding services available to school age youth with disabilities under the federal "Individuals with Disabilities Education Act."

<u>Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry</u> hosts information about employment, vocational training and other services available for adults with disabilities through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR).

<u>Achieva</u>, an organization based in Pittsburgh, PA, provides training for families and informational updates on service system changes so that appropriate planning can be done and informed choices made about needed services for family members with disabilities.
